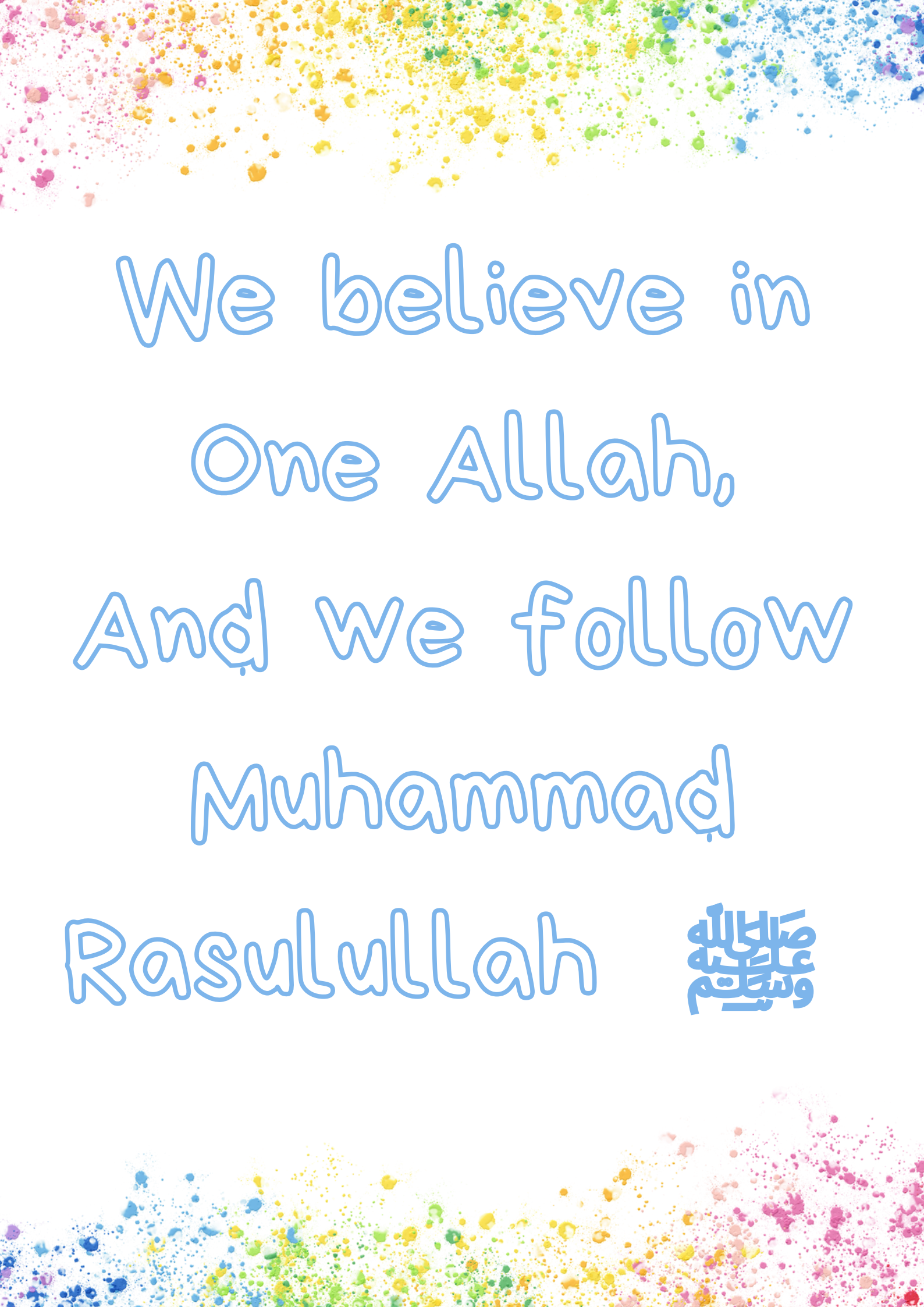

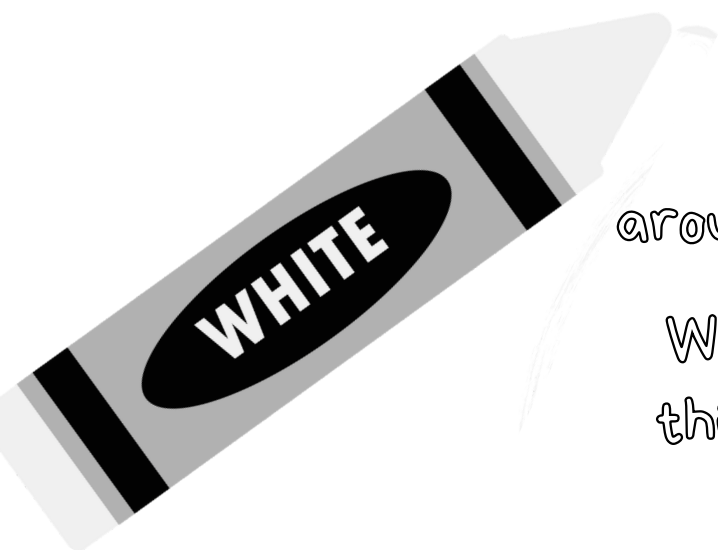
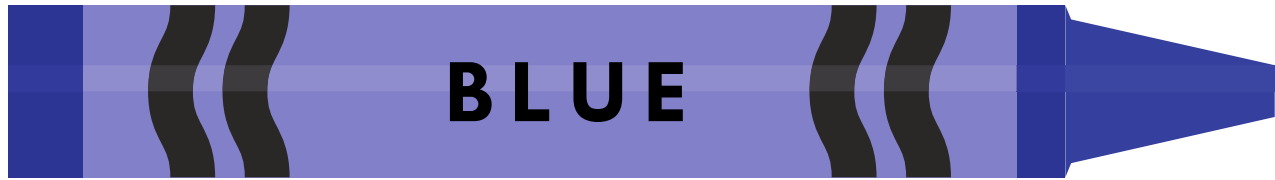

He knows best always.

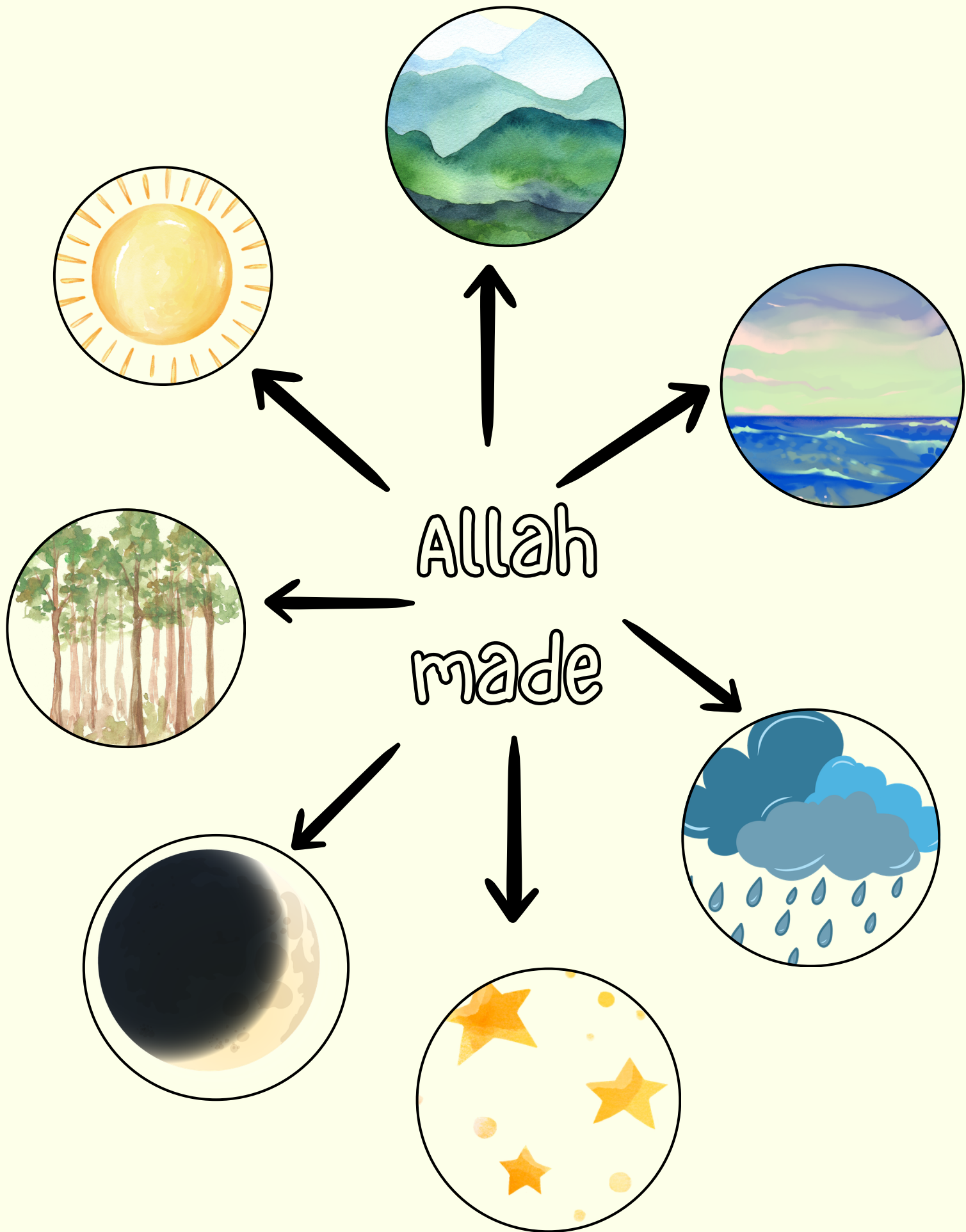

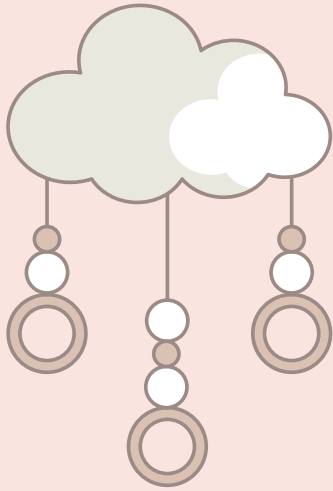

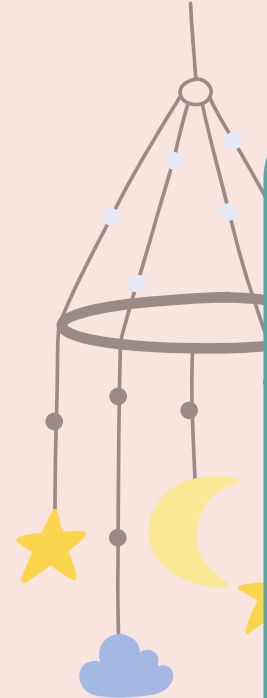
My Allah made everything

The Quality of Faith (the First Kalimah)



What you will need:

- 1- Felt (any colours)
- 2- String
- 3- Lollipop sticks (optional)
- 4- Print out of the creation circles
- 5- Glue/sellotape
- 6- Scissors
- 7- Toy Stuffing (optional)



Firstly, Cut out the images on pg.16. You can stick on to felt, coloured paper or card (cut out into raindrops)

After put it together with string or ribbon.

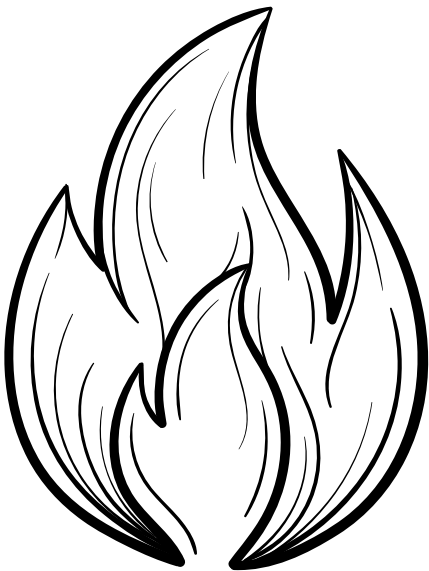
Cut out 2 white felt pieces into a cloud shape sew together leaving a gap to fill in some toy stuffing. Sew the gap shut; after it's filled to your liking. then attach the coloured raindrops. Your 'Allah's creation mobile' is now ready!

Have the "Allah made everything" nasheed playing while doing this.

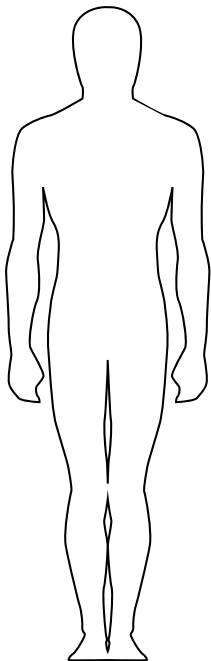

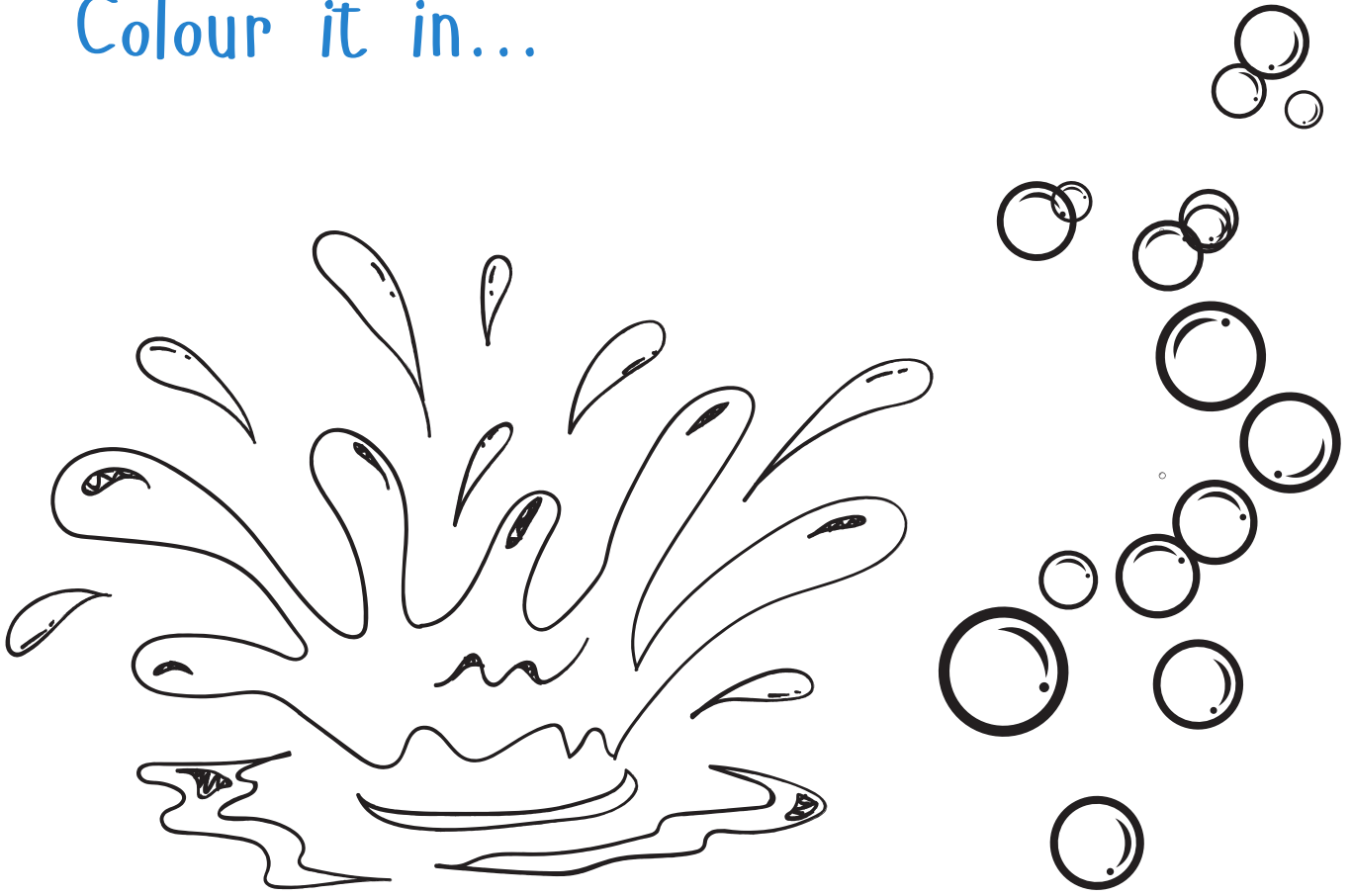


Allah made the

Who is the biggest Shaytan?

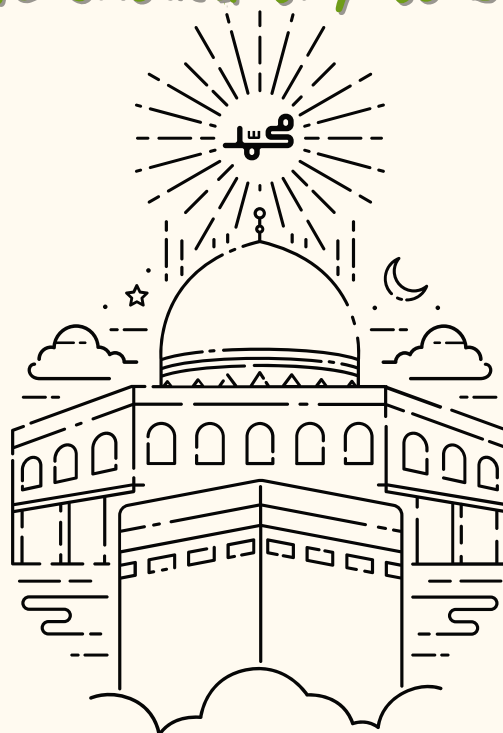


Allah sent down many Prophets onto this Earth. About 124,000!
